Minor Personal Injury

- Attempt to render first aid and/or transport to Lockport Memorial Hospital emergency room at 5875 S. Transit Rd, Lockport NY 14094. General Telephone # 716-433-9525.
- Directions to Hospital: Head South on Main Rd to Campbell Blvd. At signal, turn left on Campbell Blvd. Turn Right onto Lockport Rd. which turns into Robinson Rd. Turn Left at S. Transit Rd. Turn Right into Lockport Memorial Hospital.

Major Medical Emergency, Stroke or Heart Attack

• Call 911. Our location is behind Wendelville Fire station #2.

Serious Personal Injury and/or Vehicle, Property Damage by RC Aircraft

- Serious incident--- Call 911 and attempt to render first aid, immediately report to the Safety Officer or other officers, if necessary, call AMA as soon as possible. Do not leave the scene unless it is necessary to transport the injured.
- The AMA member causing the accident should call AMA Headquarters and provide an initial report of the incident. Severe injury and major property damage losses must be reported immediately. AMA will forward the appropriate claim form with specific instructions to the member, and/or club officer.
- To report an incident, request claim forms, or inquire about filing procedures please call the AMA at (765) 287-1256 or e-mail claims@modelaircraft.org. Regular business hours are Monday through Friday, 8 am to 5 pm EST. To report an incident that involved serious injuries to individuals outside the AMA's regular business hours, please call (765) 749-9210. This information is merely a summary. Complete details of coverage, reporting periods, and exceptions are contained in master policies available at www.modelaircraft.org/documents.aspx, documents #500-L, 500-LA, 500-M, and 500-N.
- AMA insurance is "secondary" or "excess" insurance. So, in addition to notifying AMA Headquarters of the accident, this also means an AMA member must first file the incident through any other insurance available to him or her: i.e., homeowners, renters, automobile, health insurance, etc. If the primary insurance covers the total claim amount, the member should let the AMA know so that they may close the file.
- Fire --- Attempt to use a fire extinguisher if available, call 911 if necessary.

Severe Weather

• When severe weather approaches cease flight operations and retreat to your car. If you hear thunder, then leave the facility immediately.

First Aid Kit

• Please report any materials used from the Safety Box to the Safety Officers, or any one of the other club officers so that we can continue to keep the Safety Box properly supplied.

Assault, Uncontrolled Emotional Event, Theft

- If in progress, call 911, do not confront or aggravate the individual(s)
- Attempt first aid, call 911 if needed and ask other members to direct the police and ambulance to the area from the street if possible.
