### LIPO BATTERY STORAGE

As you start to wind down your flying for the year, remember that it's best not to store LiPo batteries fully charged. It's easy to forget during the year when you're flying all the time but you should definitely go through your packs at the end of the season and safely discard any that are puffy or worn out.

Make a list of what you'll need to purchase in the Spring to replace them so you won't forget. The packs that you're keeping should be charged/discharged to storage voltage and stored safely for the winter.

LiPo batteries should be stored at a cool and dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Ideally, a fireproof LiPo bag or metal container is recommended for storage to enhance safety.

The September meeting and picnic was a lot of fun. This was the final picnic of the year. No more cookies from Al until 2026!




